



Biathlon Association of Manitoba Provincials Championships February 22 & 23, 2025

1. Event Information

1.1.Location:

All competitions will take place at the Provincial range located at Falcon Trails Resort, Falcon Lake MB. Falcon Trails Resort Biathlon Range is located on Treaty 3 - traditional lands of the Anishinabewaki くってさいか and Michif Piyii (Métis) people.

Once you turn off the #1 Highway into Falcon Lake, take the South Shore Road along the south side of the lake (past the golf course and the lumber yard). We are located right at the end of the road, about a 20 minute drive from the highway.

1.2.Biathlon Canada Membership:

All athletes, coaches and officials shall have a valid <u>2024-2025 Biathlon Canada membership</u> to be eligible to participate. This requirement is for insurance purposes.

1.3.Competition Fees:

IBU and Adult classes 45.00 full weekend; 35.00 for single day; U17 classes 40.00 full weekend; 30.00 for single day and EcoAim U11 30.00 full weekend; 20.00 for single day.

1.4. Registration for Volunteers, Officials, Coaches, and Competitors:

<u>Please register on Zone4</u> before 8 pm on Wednesday, Feb 19, 2025. Registrations will open by 5 pm on Tuesday, Jan 28, 2025. **NO** late registrations/on-site registrations.

1.5. Cancellation Policy:

If the event is canceled prior to the weekend of the races due to weather, a full refund less the online service charge will be provided. The event may be canceled or delayed if the temperature is below -20 C or feels like -25 C with wind. The host committee may modify the race formats, start times or race distances before or on the day of the race according to conditions.

1.8.Classes and competition formats²:

Notes:

- Adult 1 and Standing U17 Boys/Girls classes will follow Biathlon Canada's range carry procedure, picking up their rifle from a rifle rack at the entrance to the range, skiing to their shooting mat, and dropping off the rifle on a rifle rack at the exit of the range.
- Youth Men/Women, Junior Men/Women, Men/Women, Adult 2, Adult 3 and Adult 4 classes will carry their rifle while skiing on course.
- Penalty loops for misses will be skied. Large penalty loops (150m) for the IBU classes and smaller penalty loops (75m) for all other unless posted otherwise in the chart above.
- For Eco Aim course and loop distances may be altered by request of competitors and/or their coaches.
- Dev 1 Distances and the size of shooting targets can be modified at the request of competitors and/or their coaches.
- During competitions, Eco Aims Rifles will be placed with rifle rests on shooting mats and shared by all athletes competing in these classes.
- The Competition Jury may use discretion in awarding time penalties to ensure fair and safe competitions and will try to avoid disqualifications in following classes: Adult 1, U17 Prone, U17 Standing, Development 1, Development 2 and Eco Aims.

1.9 Course Loop Distances will be indicated at the Competition Office and marked by colour on course: A trail map is available at the end of the Race Notice page 6.

1.10. Waxing:

There are no indoor waxing facilities at the race site.

Biathlon Canada Canadian Hosting Policy Section 9 will apply:

9.1 General: A full fluoro ban applies for all Biathlon Canada sanctioned events. This ban on fluorinated waxes was implemented to protect the health of both people and the environment. High Fluoro (HF), Medium Fluoro (MF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes, including HF, MF or LF powders, pucks, blocks and liquids, and cold-weather powder additives and hardeners containing fluoros are prohibited.
